Not many children got the opportunity that I got as a new refugee in this country. I never had to struggle with my homework, school projects, school supplies, etc. We did much more than just school related activities, including Bible study, singing, computer training, and community integration. FHF staff and tutors became family to me. Mr. Bennett led me to Jesus; I remember being at one of those big conferences at First Baptist Atlanta and finally accepting Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.

My experience with the volunteers at FHF was the best I could ever ask for. I was quite stubborn when I started my journey at FHF, but I left there with so much potential for success. The volunteers I worked with such as Mrs. Susan, Mrs. Debbie, Mr. Ed, Auntie Idong, and many more, all had their hearts in what they did with us. I seriously don't know where I would be today if I didn't have such role models at the time that I did.

I now live in Cedar Falls, Iowa where I attend the University of Northern Iowa. I am majoring in elementary education with a minor in English as a Second Language. I plan to teach in the urban schools somewhere in Iowa then hopefully teach internationally. I work and live off campus. Aside from school, I'm also very involved in the church back home (Des Moines) and the community as well. I am the Sunday school teacher there (an inspiration from Mr. Bennett and Auntie Idong) and a calling from the Lord. I still sing in the church choir! I am also the secretary of a nonprofit youth organization, the United Babondo (a Congolese youth group) Youth.

We have had an exciting year at FHF and are looking forward to what God will do next year!

We ended last year's after school program with **58 CHILDREN**. **200 CHILDREN** attended camp last summer and we emphasized the STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) curriculum.

During the year, we nourished our connections with many of the refugee and at-risk families at the Lakes Apartment complex in Clarkston through our food pantry and household supplies.

Through all of this, **21 PEOPLE** prayed to receive Christ this year, and many gospel seeds were planted. We have also begun partnering with a Church in the Metro Atlanta area to provide discipleship for these new believers.

If you received our newsletter this summer, you may recall that we began renting another apartment at the Lakes to make up for lost office space at Clarkston International Bible Church/Send Relief Hub during their construction.

We only planned on having 40 children in our after-school program due to the reduced space.

WE HAVE 20 MORE CHILDREN ON OUR WAIT LIST WE WOULD LIKE TO ENROLL IF GOD PROVIDES SPACE AND FUNDING.



Our costs include salaries for lead teachers and their assistants. We believe investing in these people who relate to our students every day is crucial. We also value our volunteers who can spend one on one time with the neediest of children.

We ask that you pray for the Lord to supply the additional teachers and the money we need to pay them, so we can enroll all the children on the wait list. We will also need more volunteers for these additional students.

Finally, we have been granted **\$35,000 in a matching gift fund** for our end of the year giving drive. If we can match that gift, we will have enough to pay our 12 teachers and assistants, supply snacks for the children, and purchase the food and supplies needed for our summer camp next year!
